



- 1920** – Their mothers can vote for the first time.
- 1965** – Title VII of the Civil Rights Act gives them protections against discrimination on the basis of gender.
- 1973** – Roe v. Wade, they can make their own decisions about their own bodies.
- 1974** – They can apply for credit under their own names, without needing a male to co-sign.
- 1978** – They can no longer be fired for being pregnant.
- 1993** – Supreme Court rules it is illegal to sexually harass them in their workplace.
- 2013** – Their daughters can serve our country in combat.
